The uniqueness of our show was in the choice of our events. Tiny tots reciting Vivekananda's quotes, slokas from 'The Bhagavad Gita', making rangolis with flowers, the ramp walks portraying great personalities like Yusuf Malalah, Mother Theresa, Velu Nachiyaar etc all by the KG department, computer parts, scrap art, best out of waste, flora and fauna of exotic species etc. all being personified by the primary kids in a fancy dress display, Aathichudi in Sanskrit and mono-acting portraying great leaders in Hindi rendered by the middle school students, Triangles and angles depicted by the middle school students in Yoga forms, band music 'Sci-tunes' (presented from the instruments designed using recycled materials) with lyrics written and choreographed by the students, theatrical performances in the form of drama ('parts of Speech', 'R.K. Narayanan's Malgudi Days' etc by the English Department, 'Unity in Diversity' & 'Revolt of 1847' by the Social Science Department, 'Kadadi yezhu vallalgal' by the Tamil Department) are a few to name. 

































CELEBRATIONS OF THE REGIONAL FESTIVALS IN MVM,





